

CONTRACT FOR 4-H LARGE ANIMAL CLIPPER CHECK OUT

Conditions for borrowing 4H large animal clippers:

1. Clippers will be checked to a 4H adult volunteer leader only, who is personally responsible for their return in clean condition with all parts in place, in the travel case, and by the time stated above. Borrower is to exercise care when using the clippers, and to read the instruction manual before use if unfamiliar with the use of large animal clippers.
2. 4H adult volunteer leader will leave a refundable \$35 deposit when checking out the clippers. Deposit is NOT refundable if the clippers are returned dirty, or late.
3. 4H club or 4H adult volunteer will provide the correct size blades for the clipper checked out. Blades are not provided by the 4H Office with the clippers.
4. Clippers may only be checked out for 3 hour periods during the week of the Trinity County Fair, Tuesday – Sunday. Clippers checked out the week before the fair, must be returned to the 4H Office by 4pm on Monday of fair week.
5. 4H adult volunteer is not to lend the clippers to another party during the checkout period, and will return clippers directly to the 4-H Office or the 4-H Program Representative.
6. Club or adult individual is financially responsible for the replacement cost or repair of the clippers, if through negligence or mishap the clippers are lost or returned in a broken or inoperable condition.

Current costs as of 2/11/09 to replace the clippers are as follows:
